REGISTERED NURSE

The registered nurse provides teaching and counseling during the period of pregnancy, labor /delivery and postpartum.

Qualifications:

Must have BSN or MSN and at least one year of providing community health, pediatric and /or maternal/infant nursing services; or a Diploma or ADN and at least two years of community health, pediatric and /or maternal/infant nursing services. A valid Michigan license to practice nursing in Michigan is also required.

- Strong decision making and problem-solving skills and able to perform all essential duties and responsibilities under pressure.
- Experience conducting ASQ and ASQ-E.
- Computer/technical skills in Microsoft Word, Excel, E-mail, and the Internet.
- Reliable and professional in all aspects of work, must have a flexible schedule, must be culturally competent and work well in a team environment.

Responsibilities:

- Provides comprehensive assessments across multiple domains including health risks, drug use, domestic violence, infant health, social work support services, case management, and psychosocial education to pregnant and postpartum women and to mothers of infants.
- Assessment of client's knowledge of Labor/Delivery and the complications of pregnancy.
- Referral to Childbirth Education classes and Prenatal classes.
- Assess client's knowledge of newborn care, immunization status of other children living in the home, well childcare in the community, available dental care, and available methods of family planning.
- Adhering to all HIPPA, PHI, State and Great Start MIHP policies and rules.
